Dear Parents / Carers

School were contacted late yesterday afternoon by a member of our staff to inform us that they have tested positive for the coronavirus.

We have contacted Public Health England and we have been advised to inform you that you need to self-isolate for 14 days, if you have been in attendance at school recently. The 14 day self-isolation is for students, staff and everyone in the household, even if you are not showing any symptoms.

The school will be closed for the next 14 days, to all students and staff.

Symptoms are as follows;

- a temperature of 37.8 degrees or above
- a new continuous cough

We are currently waiting for further advice from Public Health England in regards to whether pupils and staff with underlying health conditions are required to be tested for the virus.

We recognise that this is an unsettling time for all of us and wish to reassure you that we are working closely with Public Health England to provide you with the most up to date information. Please continue to check our website and Parentmail where we will continue to keep you notified.
