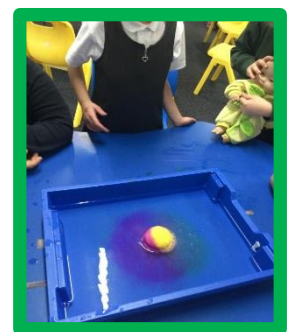


We have Poppies available for a donation.

Unfortunately, we cannot provide face-to-face meetings at this time. However, I would like to offer you the opportunity to participate in virtual meetings.

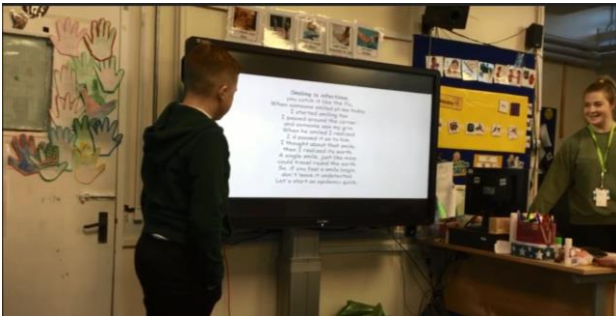
We have dedicated certain days during the week commencing 16th November for parents evening consultations.
